Clarification on Project Proponent Registration Representation under Grandparenting Process

Notice

This notice is issued by the VCS Association and serves to confirm the circumstances under which the project proponent registration representation (PPRR) is not required under the project registration process.

Section 5 of the *VCS Project Registration and VCU Issuance Process* document (available on the VCS website) sets out that under the grandparenting process, where the entity initiating the project registration process is not the project proponent, the PPRR is not a required project document. Where the entity initiating the project registration process is the project proponent and for projects following the normal project registration process (i.e., not following the grandparenting process), the PPRR is a required project document.

This notice shall be uploaded on the VCS project database in place of the PPRR for projects that are not required to submit a PPRR. For the purpose of clarity, it shall also be uploaded for projects already registered on the VCS project database that do not require a PPRR.
