Subject: **Emission Reductions under the VCS program not to be claimed under any other GHG program – Declaration.**

Dear Sir,

We wish to confirm that the Emission Reductions are for the VCS Verification Period of 6 June 2008 until 21 November 2008. The "29.70 MW wind power project in Karnataka, India" for which VCUs are claimed was registered as a CDM project No.1949 by the UNFCCC on 20 November 2008.


The Emission Reductions for the day of 20 November 2008 which is the overlapping period are being claimed as VCUs under VCS. The cut-off point between the VCS Program and the UNFCCC CDM program is the meter reading and calibration made on 21 November 2008 independently by the Karnataka State utility. Necessary evidence is attached as Annexure 1, and has been also provided to and verified by the DOE, Bureau Veritas Certification (India) Pvt. Ltd. amongst other documents.

We confirm that the Emission Reductions presented for VCU issuance have not been claimed or issued under the UNFCCC CDM program or any other approved GHG program and this also applies to the overlapping period i.e. the day of 20 November 2008. We have no intention of claiming Emission Reductions being claimed under the VCS program again under the UNFCCC CDM program or any other program in future.
