**Project 2998: Verra response to the exemption requested from Section 4.1.27 of the VCS Registration and Issuance Process, v4.6. submitted on 18 November 2024**

Verra grants an exemption allowing for an extension of rule from Section 4.1.27 of the VCS Standard, v4.7, to project 2998, “Brascarbon Methane Recovery Project BCA-BRA-16’ as the project proponent had limited control and the situation was unforeseeable.

**Explanation:**

The PP is allowed to carry out the second verification by the same VVB who was involved in validation and first verification of this project. Furthermore, the PP shall contact a different VVB for subsequent verification except ICONTEC, since this VVB has carried out the validation, first verification and second verification from 01-02-2022 to 31-12-2023.

Exemptions are granted by Verra on a case-by-case basis and do not form the basis of or set a precedent for future exemption request approvals or denials.

This letter will be uploaded to the Verra Registry as a public document.

**Background to the extension request:**

This letter is in reference to your exemption request submitted to Verra on 18 November 2024. It is our understanding that Icontec, as the VVB failed to recognize that in accordance with Section 4.1.27.1 of the VCS standard the rotation of VVB is required starting from the second subsequent verification. This prompted the VVB and PP to request for an exemption against Section 4.1.27 of the VCS Standard, v4.7.
