Summary:

An accuracy review of the Distribution of Improved cook stove - Phase VI, Validation and Verification request has been conducted by Verra in accordance with Section 4.3 of the Registration and Issuance Process.

The accuracy review has raised 1 assessment finding detailed below. The VVB, in coordination with the project proponent, is hereby required to provide a response to the assessment findings presented in Section 1. The assessment finding must be addressed to the satisfaction of Verra.

This project review report will be made publicly available. Confidential information may be provided as separate attachments.

1. ASSESSMENT FINDINGS

Finding 1

Based on the documentation submitted, the monitoring period is 15/12/2012 to 14/12/2017 and the project start date is 05/04/2011. The PP/VVB has confirmed that the “operational lifetime of the cook stove is 5 years 00 months”; and that “the cook stove will be replaced as and when 5 years 00 months is over.” However in Section 3.1 of the Monitoring Report, it is stated that, “in the current monitoring period of 5 years none of the improved cookstoves have been replaced.”

The project proponent and the VVB are requested to demonstrate how the cookstoves were operational beyond the five years from the project start date (05/04/2011). The PP/VVB is also requested to provide further information on the efficiency of the cook stoves after 05/04/2011 considering that they were operating beyond their operational lifetime.

Project Proponent Response:

The project encompasses distribution of 14,450 improved cook stoves (ICS) in two districts of Maharashtra namely Satara and Solapur.

The sequential steps involved in distribution of ICS are

1. Step I- Identification of beneficiary based on the beneficiary selection criteria
2. Step II- Supply of Improved cookstoves by M/s Vikram Cookstoves at Block Development Office
3. Step III – Signing of agreement between Project Proponent (M/s G K Energy Marketers) and Beneficiaries
4. Step IV- Supply of ICS from Block Development Office to Village Panchayat
5. Step V- Distribution of ICS to beneficiary through representation from Panchayat Office by the representatives of Project Proponent and Cookstoves suppliers.

The start date considered in the PDD (05/04/2011) pertains to the delivery of 1st lot of 1060 ICS by M/s Vikram Cookstoves to Block Development Office in Solapur and does not resemble to the distribution of ICS to beneficiaries. But since the activity is a real action in terms of the project the same was considered as start date in line with the start date definition of CDM (delivery challan submitted).

Supply of 14,450 number of ICS from manufacturing unit of M/s Vikarm Cookstoves and Fabricators to the beneficiary starting from the date of first accounted activity took around two years. This include initial supply of ICS from workstation of M/s Vikarm to the Block Development office, and thereafter from Block Development office to Panchyat Office followed by distribution of ICS on condition of agreement being signed between the beneficiary and project proponent. The ICS was distributed during:

1. October 12th and 13th 2012 in Solapur
2. October 15th and 16th 2012 in Satara

The dates of ICS distribution as outlined above and also specified in the ER estimation sheets (submitted) resembles to the distribution dates for the entire mass of ICS across the two districts. Since the distribution date resembles to generation of GHG emission reductions the same is to be considered as start date for VCS project.

It is to be noted that the lifetime of an ICS is accounted from the date of operation of ICS and not from the date of supply to an interim logistics point (project start date of 05/01/2011 currently under consideration). The date of actual handover of ICS to beneficiary is the date from when the operation is actually initiated and is therefore considered as date for onset of lifetime assessment.

The ICS in general operates for over seven years beyond the proposed lifetime period provided adequate maintenance services are provided (established through warranty from the original manufacturer M/s Vikram Cookstoves and Fabricators). The manufacturer of improved cookstoves also entrusted with the responsibilities of periodic operation and maintenance certified regarding the operational conditions of the devices at per with users' satisfaction and its operational compliance with the applicable environmental and

safety norms based on their assessment after the end of the life time of the project.

Efficiency of the ICS assessed during periodic monitoring post each crediting period has only depicted reduction in operational efficiency is being considered under emission reduction calculation without and issues of operational performance. It is to be noted

1. The end of fifth monitoring period (14/12/2017) is within additional two months of the project lifetime of the ICS (five years and two month). With manufacturer warranty of its operational life time of seven years additional two month of operation post lifetime is justified. Continuous and periodic operation and maintenance facilitated by the service provider has also ensured operation of ICS at optimal efficiency post specified lifetime.
2. Manufacturer of the ICS responsible for O&M also certified about of ICS operations with users' satisfaction post specified life time (of five years) based on the scheduled inspection.
3. The third-party survey of ICS operation and its operational efficiency carried out post fifth year of monitoring period and also beyond the ICS lifetime on two parameters in line with the monitoring plan of the registered PDD. The parameters monitored includes
 - a. Percentage of beneficiaries using ICS during the crediting period
 - b. Operational efficiency of the improved cookstoves.

Assessment beyond fifth year of operation /during the sixth year of usage revealed drop in ICS operational efficiency in the range of 6% and is conservatively considered as part of emission reduction calculations.

The replacement of ICS was carried post completion of third-party monitoring (relating to use of ICS and its operational efficiency) after the end of fifth monitoring period.

VVB Response:

VVB has checked the installation dates for the ICS distributed in Satara & Solapur districts. The distribution of ICS under the project activity have been done in the month of October 2012. Further, the ICS have been maintained for wear tear of the ICS. Thus, the operational lifetime of the cookstove are more than default 5 years. Till the end of the monitoring period there was no any replacement of cookstove have been happened.

Further, PP have carried out monitoring surveys and third-party efficiency tests as per the monitoring plan. The annualised drop in efficiency have been considered for calculations of emission reductions.

Verra Response:

The justification provided by the PP for the Project start date, that is, "start date considered in the PDD (05/04/2011) pertains to the delivery of 1st lot of 1060 ICS by M/s Vikram Cookstoves to Block Development Office in Solapur and does not resembles to the distribution of ICS to beneficiaries" does not meet the VCS definition. According to Section 3.7 of the VCS Standard v4.1, the "project start date of a non-AFOLU project is the date on which the project began generating GHG emission reductions or removals."

From the sequential steps involved in distribution of ICS explained above, the project proponent and VVB are further requested to clarify why it deemed that distribution of ICS to beneficiary is not the start date of the project in accordance with VCS definition.

Project Proponent Response & VVB Response:

The start date outlined under Section 1.8 of the of the "Project Description" document resembles to date of delivery of 1st lot of 1060 ICS by the supplier (M/s Vikram Cookstoves) to State Government office (Block Development Office) in the district of Solapur (Reference CDM PDD) and therefore complies to CDM start date definitions. The sequential steps outlined above is to clarify that the cookstoves were actually distributed to the beneficiaries after all 14450 ICS were received from the supplier at the local office of the state government and upon signing of contract. Distribution at the same point of time was carried out by the project proponent to ensure timely (a) operation and maintenance sequence (b) timely monitoring and replacement

schedule.

The date of supply of ICS to government office for purpose of future distribution does not resemble to VCS definition of start date as cookstoves was not hand overed to the beneficiaries on the same date and therefore actual GHG emission reduction was not achieved. It is therefore clarified that 05/04/2011 is not the date of distribution of ICS to beneficiary and thereof is not the start date.

As outlined in the response above the ICS was hand overed to beneficiaries in both the location in the month of October 2012 and the earliest of the distribution date (12/10/2012) of both the location is the actual start date of the project as per VCS definition.

Verra Response:

The justification provided by the PP for the Project start date is sufficient to close this finding. However, the PP and VVB have clarified that “05/04/2011 is not the date of distribution of ICS to beneficiary and thereof is not the start date.” The PP is required to update the Project Description document and all other relevant documents to reflect the actual start date (12/10/2012).
