Dear Erin, Kaviraj, Ranjan, Agustin, Carla, Kaushal and Praveen,

Verra has completed its review of the above project (the “Project”) and reinstated it in the VCS Program.

On 27 June 2024, Verra opened a new review of the Project pursuant to Section 6 of the *VCS Registration and Issuance Process, v4.5*, and sent three review reports to the respective validation/verification bodies.

The review concluded that 278,540 VCUs were issued to the project in excess of the correct amount. Under Section 6.1.5 of the *VCS Registration and Issuance Process, v4.5* the project proponent is responsible for remedying this excess VCU issuance, which it has done through cancellation of a corresponding number of VCUs.
