1 – Annual Reporting

(a) a summary of the recent activities, events and actions related to the Project:

From March to September 2019 (6 months), the project broadcast radio commercials (on Radio Horizon 2000) to promote its LPG equipment.

The project also participated in several exhibition events and organized some promotional campaigns to facilitate access to clean energy for people facing economic constraints.

In spite of the riots that affected the country, the distribution of LPG stoves increased by 13% in 2019 compared to 2018 thanks to the different visibility and promotion activities of the project.

There is a **unique phone number** on which clients may provide grievances: **(509) 38 83 27 02**. From this telephone number, all queries are processed and/or forwarded to the relevant department. This number is available on the sale receipt and on communication flyers.

In addition to this, a **dedicated person** from the staff calls **all beneficiaries** from the database **biannually** from which we have contact details.

There is also a **specific after-sales service department** which is in charge of the maintenance and repairs of the equipment distributed within the framework of the project and of beneficiaries' assistance.

(d) any incidents or events that may impact the Outcomes/Impacts delivered to date (in terms of loss) or the ongoing Performance of the Project.

Since July 2018, Haiti has been experiencing both a socio-economic and political crisis. This situation is characterized by frequent street demonstrations, untimely stoppages of activities, a deterioration of the security situation and excesses of violence making certain areas completely inaccessible.

During the year 2019, the country experienced 3 sequences of shutdowns ranging from 7 days to 2 months:

Date	Description
From February, 7th to 14th, 2019	Activities shutdown due to the political situation
From June, 10yh to 21, 2019	Activities shutdown due to the political situation

From September 16th, to November, 8th, 2019	Activities shutdown due to the political situation
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Economically, the situation is also difficult. The inflation rate is close to 20% for the year 2019. This weakens the purchasing power of households and affects especially low-income households. The prices of domestic LPG stoves increased by 19% on average during 2019. The precarious situation of households has increased with a direct impact on the project volume of sales (LPG equipments).

Taking advantage of the relative calm at the end of the year, the project is launching a special promotion for domestic LPG equipment in order to boost sales a little.
