Project 2349, Installation of high efficiency wood burning cookstoves in Kenya, Review Completion Notification

Dear Erin,

Verra has completed its review of the above project (the “Project”) and taken it off hold in the Verified Carbon Standard (VCS) Program.

On 27 June 2024, Verra opened a new review of the Project pursuant to Section 6 of the *VCS Registration and Issuance Process, v4.5*, and sent review reports to the respective validation/verification bodies (VVBs). The VVBs responded to the reports and all findings are now closed.

The review concluded that 186,407 VCUs were issued to the project in excess of the correct amount. Under Section 6.1.5 of the *VCS Registration and Issuance Process, v4.5* the project proponent is responsible for compensating for this excess VCU issuance, which it has done through cancellation of a corresponding number of VCUs.
