Dear P S Prasad,

This letter is in reference to your request submitted to Verra on 17 September 2011. It is our understanding that you are requesting an exemption from Section 3.7.5 of the *VCS Standard v3*, which requires projects with a start date before 1 January 2002 to register with the VCS Program no later than 1 October 2011.

Based on the information provided to Verra, it is understood that this project intended to register with the VCS program. However, based on unforeseen circumstances and the revision to the *VCS Standard, v4.0*, which removed Section 3.7.5, the project was unable to gap validate and register.

Verra has determined that Manglam Timber Productes has met the spirit of the rules as outlined by Verra and only were delayed past the deadline of 1 October 2011 due to force majeure events outside of their control. Further it was determined Manglam Timber Productes has not breached the rules and requirements expressly outlined in the *Verified Carbon Standard, v4.0* and accompanying documents. Considering the particular circumstances leading to this request, and the background information presented, Verra is able to grant the project proponent, Manglam Timber Products, a waiver of the 1 October 2011 deadline for projects with a start date before 1 January 2002 to register with the VCS Program.

Please note that exemptions are granted by Verra on a case-by-case basis and do not form the basis of, or set a precedent for, future exemption request approvals.
