Project 3115: Response to exemption submitted on 12 February 2024

Verra grants an exemption from Section 4.3.5(4) of the *Registration and Issuance Process v4.4* to project 3115.

Next steps:

The project must re-submit the project review report (PRR) by **30 June 2024**, failing which the project request will be denied.

Exemptions are granted by Verra on a case-by-case basis and do not form the basis of, or set a precedent for, future exemption request approvals or denials. This letter will be uploaded to the Verra Registry as a public document.

Background to the exemption request:

This letter is in reference to your exemption request submitted to Verra on 12 February 2024. It is our understanding that the project proponent, Vedic Green Solutions, is requesting an exemption from Section 4.3.5(4) of the *Registration and Issuance Process v4.4* for Sustainable Agricultural Practices for carbon sequestration by Organic and Natural farming groups (ID3115). The exemption requested by the project proponent is to extend the current 60-day PRR deadline, i.e., 29 March 2024, for an additional 90 business days.

Based on the information provided to Verra, it is understood that the Sustainable Agricultural Practices for carbon sequestration by Organic and Natural farming groups is unable to adhere to the 60-day deadline due to the unavailability of some farmers given the ongoing planting season.
