Next steps:

- If the loss event qualifies as a Loss Event (see the *VCS Program Definitions* for the definition of a Loss Event), the project proponent must submit a Loss Event Report within two years of the loss event's discovery date, and before the subsequent verification approval is requested (adhering to Section 5.3.1 – 5.3.3 of the *VCS Registration and Issuance Process v4.4*).
- If the loss event does not qualify as a Loss Event, the project proponent must clearly demonstrate this in the monitoring report of the subsequent verification. During the verification, the VVB must assess this.

This letter will be uploaded to the Verra Registry as a public document.

Additional information

In a communication dated 23/07/24, the project proponent informed Verra that an event occurred in the project area that is likely to qualify as a loss event (see *VCS Program Definitions*).
