Assessment Summary

The project has some positive signs, including VVB-confirmed additionality, FPIC, a grievance mechanism, and a recent baseline reassessment. However, several core risk items are weakly documented or not addressed, especially leakage justification, reversal treatment, and the reliability of key monitoring figures. The low extraction confidence and multiple document contradictions reduce confidence in the record.

Red Flags

- Leakage is shown as a 0% deduction, but the justification is not addressed in the extracted documents.
- Key figures and project terms conflict across documents, including FNRB, usage rates, benefit sharing, and the crediting period.

Score Breakdown

Integrity — 4.8 / 10

+ Additionality was confirmed by the VVB, and the baseline was reassessed in 2024.

- Leakage justification is not addressed, and reversal treatment is only a generic no-extreme-event statement with no buffer pool information found.

The project benefits from VVB-confirmed additionality and a baseline that was reassessed in 2024, which supports the core project design. Still, leakage is weak because the extracted record shows a 0% deduction while the justification is not addressed, and no buffer pool percentage was found. Reversal risk is also only lightly handled: the validation report says no extreme event caused reversal, but there is no stronger permanence mechanism documented.

Transparency — 4.2 / 10

+ The monitoring period is clearly stated as 2023-01-01 to 2024-12-31, and the VVB is named.

- Total ERs claimed and verified are not found in the extracted record, and extraction confidence is low.

The monitoring period is clearly stated and the VVB is identified as Earthood Services Limited, which helps traceability. However, total ERs claimed and verified are not found in the extracted record, limiting public accounting clarity. The low extraction confidence further reduces confidence that the documentation is complete and readable.

Claim Safety — 4.1 / 10

+ The verified and assumed usage rates are both reported at 95, which at least suggests internal consistency within the latest record.

- The FNRB value of 0.85 conflicts with an earlier national-default value in the contradiction log, and leakage is not well justified.

Claim safety is weakened by the lack of a clear leakage rationale and by contradictions in the record. The contradiction log shows different FNRB values across documents, and the latest extracted value of 0.85 is not clearly reconciled against the earlier national-default figure. The usage rate is reported as 95 in the latest record, but the presence of multiple conflicting versions of key assumptions raises over-crediting risk.

Documentation — 3.3 / 10

+ The record includes many source documents, with 31 documents used, and it notes FPIC, grievance, and benefit-sharing information.

- Extraction confidence is low, and several corrective actions and forward actions indicate unresolved monitoring and evidence gaps.

The file set is fairly broad, with 31 documents used, and it includes safeguards, FPIC, grievance, and benefit-sharing references. Even so, the extraction confidence is low, which suggests at least one key document was hard to read. The validation report also lists several closed CARs and FARs, showing that the project required multiple rounds of clarification and follow-up evidence.

What Would Improve This Score

- Provide a clear, quantified leakage assessment and explain why the 0% deduction is justified.
- Publish reconciled monitoring tables for ERs, usage rates, FNRB, and the crediting period, with a document-by-document contradiction resolution.
