Assessment Summary

The project has very limited verifiable evidence in the extracted record, with key items like additionality, baseline method, leakage treatment, and permanence safeguards not stated in available documents. The verification report shows no material findings, but the absence of core methodological details and registry/eligibility information makes the credit claim hard to assess confidently.

Red Flags

- Additionality, baseline, leakage, and permanence details are not stated in the available verification record.
- No verified error totals, registry eligibility status, or safeguard documentation were found in the extracted documents.

Score Breakdown

Integrity — 2.4 / 10

- + The verification report dated 2025-05-16 reports no material findings and no corrective actions required.
- The available record does not state the additionality test, baseline method, leakage treatment, buffer pool, or any reversal history.

The verification report dated 2025-05-16 reports no material findings and no corrective actions required, which is a modest positive. However, the extracted record does not state the additionality test, baseline method, leakage deduction, buffer pool, or any reversal events, so the core integrity case is largely unsubstantiated in the available documents.

Transparency — 2.1 / 10

- + A named VVB, Control Union Malaysia, is identified for the 2024 monitoring period.
- The extracted record does not provide verified versus claimed issuance totals, usage monitoring details, or registry completeness information.

Transparency is weak because the record does not provide verified versus claimed issuance totals, usage monitoring method, or any registry completeness details. The only clear public-facing anchor in the extracted data is the named verifier, Control Union Malaysia, for the 2024 monitoring period.

Claim Safety — 2.0 / 10

- + The project is a removal project, which can reduce some baseline-emission claim risk compared with avoidance projects.
- There is no stated baseline method, leakage justification, or eligibility status, so over-crediting and greenwashing risk remain difficult to rule out.

Claim safety is low because the record lacks the baseline method, leakage justification, and any eligibility status such as CORSIA or CCP. Without those details, it is difficult to judge over-crediting risk or whether the removal claims are robust enough for broad marketing use.

Documentation — 3.0 / 10

- + The record includes a recent verification report dated 2025-05-16 and references two evidence documents.
- Key fields are missing or not stated, and the extraction confidence is only medium, limiting confidence in the documentation package.

Documentation quality is limited: the record cites a recent verification report and two evidence documents, but most key fields are not stated in available documents. The extraction confidence is medium, which is better than low, but still leaves substantial uncertainty around the completeness of the source material.

What Would Improve This Score

- Provide the full validation and verification package showing the additionality test, baseline method, leakage assessment, and any buffer or reversal provisions.
- Disclose verified issuance totals, registry status, and explicit eligibility statements for CCP and CORSIA to reduce claim and double-counting risk.
