Assessment Summary

The project has some positive integrity signals because the VVB confirmed additionality and the verification report reported no material findings. However, key baseline, leakage, permanence, and safeguard details are not stated in the available documents, which limits confidence in the crediting claim. Transparency is weak because the extracted record does not show verified issuance quantities or core MRV parameters, and the registry information is incomplete.

Red Flags

- Baseline method, leakage treatment, and buffer pool coverage are not stated in the available documents.
- No verified issuance totals, usage monitoring method, or safeguard documentation were found in the extracted record.

Score Breakdown

Integrity — 4.8 / 10

- + Additionality was confirmed by the VVB in the verification report.
- Baseline method, leakage treatment, and reversal protection are not stated in the available documents.

The verification report confirms additionality was checked by the VVB, and it reports no material findings or corrective actions required. That supports the project, but the available record does not state the baseline method, any leakage deduction, buffer pool coverage, or reversal history, so permanence and baseline robustness cannot be well assessed.

Transparency — 3.2 / 10

- + The monitoring period is clearly stated for 2024 and the VVB is named as Control Union Malaysia.
- Verified and claimed ERR totals are not found in the extracted record, and core MRV details are missing.

The monitoring period is clearly identified as 2024-01-01 to 2024-12-31, and the VVB is named as Control Union Malaysia. However, the extracted record does not include verified or claimed ERR totals, usage monitoring method, or other core MRV details, which keeps transparency low.

Claim Safety — 3.6 / 10

- + No material findings were reported in the verification report.
- The baseline approach, leakage justification, and usage monitoring method are not stated, increasing over-crediting risk.

Claim safety is weakened by the absence of a stated baseline method, leakage justification, and usage monitoring approach. The project is a removal project, which helps, but the lack of quantified issuance and MRV details makes it difficult to rule out over-crediting risk with confidence.

Documentation — 4.1 / 10

- + Two document sources were used, including a verification report dated 2025-05-16.
- Extraction confidence is only medium, and several key fields are not stated in the available documents.

Documentation is only moderate because two official document sources were used and the verification report is dated 2025-05-16. Still, the extraction confidence is medium and many important fields are not stated in the available documents, so the record is incomplete for a high-confidence assessment.

What Would Improve This Score

- Publish the baseline methodology, leakage treatment, and any buffer pool or reversal protection details in the verification and monitoring records.
- Disclose verified issuance totals, usage monitoring procedures, and safeguard documentation such as FPIC, grievance mechanisms, and other social protections.
