## Assessment Summary

The project has very limited documented evidence in the extracted record, with key items like additionality, baseline method, leakage treatment, and permanence safeguards not stated in available documents. The verification report shows no material findings, but the absence of core methodological details makes the crediting claim difficult to assess confidently.

## Red Flags

- Core integrity elements such as additionality testing, baseline method, leakage treatment, and buffer pool coverage are not stated in available documents.
- No verified ERR totals, CCP status, or CORSIA eligibility are provided, leaving claim safety and registry risk unclear.

## Score Breakdown

### Integrity — 2.8 / 10

- + The verification report dated 2025-05-16 reports no material findings and no corrective actions required.
- Additionality, baseline method, leakage deduction, and buffer pool treatment are not stated in available documents.

The verification report for the 2024 monitoring period, dated 2025-05-16, reports no material findings and no corrective actions required, which is a modest positive. However, the extracted record does not state the additionality test, whether the VVB confirmed it, the baseline method, leakage deduction, buffer pool percentage, or any reversal history, so the core integrity case is weak.

### Transparency — 2.2 / 10

- + A named VVB, Control Union Malaysia, is identified in the verification report for the 2024 monitoring period.
- The extracted record does not state verified or claimed ERR totals, usage monitoring method, or other core MRV details.

Transparency is limited because the record does identify the VVB, Control Union Malaysia, and the monitoring period, but it does not state verified or claimed ERR totals, the usage monitoring method, or other key MRV details. The absence of these figures prevents a clear check on issuance completeness and reporting quality.

### Claim Safety — 2.0 / 10

- + The project is described as a removal project under Hemp Carbon Standard, which can reduce some baseline-emission concerns relative to avoidance projects.
- There is no stated baseline method, leakage justification, or eligibility status, so over-crediting and greenwashing risk remain unresolved.

Claim safety is low because the record does not provide the baseline method, leakage justification, or any eligibility status such as CCP or CORSIA. Without those details, it is not possible to judge over-crediting risk or whether the project could be marketed with strong quality claims.

### Documentation — 3.4 / 10

- + Two source documents were used, including a verification report and a validation report/issuance record.
- Extraction confidence is only medium, and many key fields are not stated in available documents, limiting documentation completeness.

Documentation is only partial: two documents were used, including a verification report and a validation report/issuance record, and the extraction confidence is medium. That said, many important fields are not stated in available documents, so the evidence base remains thin despite the presence of official sources.
